Spend A Lazy Day Tubing The Niobrara River

We are once again going tubing down the Niobrara River. Come join us for a leisurely afternoon tube float down several miles of the most scenic part of Nebraska you will ever encounter. Rated by Backpacker Magazine as one of the top 10 canoeing rivers in the United States, the Niobrara provides hours of enjoyment, and memories that will last for a lifetime. Travel by tube (or optional canoe) as you float through canyons and meadows. Watch for bald eagles, turkey, deer, beaver, hawks, and herons along the way! With average speeds of 4-7 mph and average depths of 18"-24" the Niobrara is ideal for first-timers and a fun trip for all ages! Visit Smith Falls state park and see the tallest waterfall in Nebraska

We will launch at Berry Bridge, which is about 1 ½ hours above Smith Falls State Park. Our stopping point at the end of the tube float is our campground which is about 3 ½ hours below Smith Falls State Park. For those of you who like to sip a beer while you tube, great news...as we will not be going through the wildlife area, there are no restrictions for the stretch of river we will be on.

Basic Info:

- Camping Dates: July 18 and 19 (Fri & Sat).
- Tubing Date: July 19 (Sat).
- Costs: \$39 per person Deadline is June 10th.
- We will be camping someplace new this time, Fritz's Island Campground, http://www.campniobrara.com. They have modern restrooms, showers a convenience store and even a bar!

Includes:

- Camping fee at Fritz Island campground for two nights, tube rental, bus transportation from our campground to the drop off point up river. The end point is right at our campground.
- Lots and lots of fun!

Available, But Not Included:

- Canoe rental instead of tube \$17 additional (can be split between two people)
- Cooler Tubes \$5.00
- If you wish to tube an additional day, this will be on your own. We can provide reservation information for you.

Not Included - You Need to Bring:

- Tent/Camping gear.
- Food (don't forget marshmallows for the campfire!)
- Sunscreen and lots of beverages!

Needed Now:

We need an e-mail or phone call from you this week to determine how many are going so we can make accurate reservations. There are only a limited amount of camping spaces and tube/canoe rentals available and we have to book early. Your check and trip application can arrive later, but I need you to contact me now to insure I reserve you a space. I need to know how many people, how many tubes (or canoes) and if you want a cooler tube.

What: Classic music by the Pointer Sisters, The Village people and more with a fireworks finale by Fireworks by Grucci.


When: Friday June 27 Where: Memorial Park, 60th Street and Underwood Avenue
