Trips Update December 2023

I wish to thank everyone for putting up with the late night emails. It has been a challenge getting airfare for the Banff trip. You will still get trip updates and information, but hopefully the amount of emails from me will slow down (at least that is my goal). We still do need to fill a few spots and get anyone who wishes to go on the March trip signed up now!

The open spots are dwindling! If you wish to go on a trip, there are limited spots available. Let's get these trips filled up!

- **Snowmass** was a great trip! Look for the trip article in next month's newsletter
- Last call for Steamboat January 20-27, 2024. The cost of the trip is \$1185 plus lift tickets if you are not an IKON pass holder. Join us on this week-long trip with the Flatland Ski Association (FSA). We will be staying at the Timber Run Condos which are 2- or 3-bedroom condos with full kitchens. They have private shuttles to the mountain. The outdoor hot tubs are nice! There are only 22 spots. We have 20 signed up so far. THERE ARE ONLY 2 SPOTS LEFT. DON'T wait to the last minute! See the trip flyer for more information.
- Early February, we will be going to **Taos NM** February 4-9, 2024. The cost of the trip is \$430 plus lift tickets. We have booked 12 spots at the Hampton Inn in Taos. We have 7 signed up. There are 5 spots left at this time. This is a drive out trip.
- Banff, Alberta, Canada Trip is full! CMSC weeklong trip 2/24-3/2/2024. See trip flyer for pricing. We will coordinate air & transfers with CMSC. You will need a passport. We are staying in the town of Banff at the Caribou Lodge. The town is a great place to explore if you are a non-skier. All three of the mountains (Sunshine, Mt Norquay and Lake Louise) are on IKON (SKIBIG3). The pricing includes lift tickets, so it will be less if you have an IKON pass. We have 24 signed up.

 I am keeping an eye on airfare. It is horribly expensive in order to get us in to Calgary in the afternoon. It does get less expensive to get in at 11:30 PM, but we would not have transfers. If you book your own air, please send the itinerary to me. I am still looking for options.

OMAHA SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- 1) Trip captain is the final authority on and during the trip.
- 2) Club members will conduct themselves in a mature manner at all times.
- 3) There will be a \$28.00 charge (subject to change according to bank fees) on any returned check.

TRIP SIGN-UP, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- 4) Only members in good standing with dues currently paid to the Omaha Ski Club may sign up for a trip. Children under the age of 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the trip. A trip application for a child under the age of 19 must be signed by a parent or guardian of the child
- 5) By signing up for a trip a member agrees to pay the Club the full cost of the trip applied for, subject to the provisions for timely cancellation in item #7. Each trip will have its own trip deposit and payment schedule to be set by the trip committee. A deposit is required to sign up for a trip. Failure to meet the payment schedule may result in automatic cancellation from the trip subject to the cancellation fee in item #7.
- 6) When a trip is full the trip captain will start a waiting list. To be placed on the waiting list a member must fill out and sign a trip application and pay the standard deposit for that trip. Waiting list members must meet the payment schedules when moving to the confirmed lists.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- 7) Unless otherwise listed in individual trip information, cancellations prior to 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$50.00; cancellations less than 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$100.00 if the trip goes full, or liability for the full cost of the trip if the trip does not go full. Any cancellation fees or penalties may first be deducted from payments the member made for the trip. Medical cancellations will be reviewed by the Board for refund determination. 8) Transferring from the waiting list on one trip to a
- confirmed list on another trip will be done with no cancellation fee. Refusal to move from the waiting list to the confirmed list will constitute automatic cancellation subject to the cancellation fee in item #7 above.
- 9) If a trip is cancelled by the club, all money paid to the club by a member for that trip will be refunded.
- 10) All members on the waiting list when the trip departs will receive a full refund.
- 11) No refunds will be made until after the trip returns.

BUS TRIPS

- 12) Smoking on buses is prohibited.
- 13) Any time the bus stops enroute to its destination, passengers leaving the bus will do so at their own risk.
