## Trips Update July 2023

Trip SIGN-UP is now open. We will not drop rooms for Banff now that there are only Eight spots left! This is good news, but now we must fill these spots or the club will take a hit for the unused rooms. We drop rooms for Steamboat in November. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO SIGN-UP. THE CLUB IS PENALIZED MONETARILY FOR DROPPED ROOMS. This year has been very different from previous years as far as obtaining rooms, early deposits and the lodging cancellation policies and penalties. I will continue to update the trips flyers. It will be IKON all the way!

- First, we will be going to Snowmass with the Cornhusker Ski Club December 10-15, 2023. The cost is \$545 plus lift tickets, if you are not an IKON Pass holder. We have 12 spots reserved and 6 signed up. THERE ARE ONLY 6 SPOTS LEFT. It is a drive-out trip. See Trips Flyer
- Next, FSA will be going to Steamboat January 20-27, 2024. The cost of the trip is \$1185. This is a week-long trip. We will be staying at the Timber Run Condos which are 2- or 3-bedroom condos with full kitchens. They have private shuttles to the mountain. The outdoor hot tubs are nice! There are only 22 spots. We have 14 signed up so far. THERE ARE ONLY 8 SPOTS LEFT. See trip flyer for more information. Please be aware of the "2 parking spots per condo unit" This is new for this year. Any additional vehicles will have to pay to park. Since this is a drive-out trip, find people that you can carpool with.
- In February, CMSC will be going to Banff, Alberta, Canada for a week. CMSC flyer states "from \$1299 without air and bus". Save the date 2/24-3/2/2024. We will coordinate air & transfers with CMSC. You will need a passport. We will stay in the town of Banff at the Caribou Lodge. The town is a great place to explore if you are a non-skier. All three of the mountains (Sunshine, Mt Norquay and Lake Louise) are on IKON (SKIBIG3). Please go to skicmsc.com website and click on CMSC Events tab and go to Chicago Week 2024. There you will find information on the trip. The pricing includes lift tickets, so it will be less if you have an IKON pass. We have 12 signed up so far. We reserved 20 spots. THERE ARE ONLY 8 SPOTS LEFT. If you wish to go, get that trip application to me soon!

I will try to get a couple more trips to fill in the gaps.

If you know that you want to go on any of these trips, just send a trip application and the deposit to hold your space. Again, please do not wait until the last minute. We may not be able to get additional rooms. Thank you!



#### **OMAHA SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES**

- 1) Trip captain is the final authority on and during the trip.
- 2) Club members will conduct themselves in a mature manner at all times.
- 3) There will be a \$28.00 charge (subject to change according to bank fees) on any returned check.

#### TRIP SIGN-UP, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- 4) Only members in good standing with dues currently paid to the Omaha Ski Club may sign up for a trip. Children under the age of 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the trip. A trip application for a child under the age of 19 must be signed by a parent or guardian of the child
- 5) By signing up for a trip a member agrees to pay the Club the full cost of the trip applied for, subject to the provisions for timely cancellation in item #7. Each trip will have its own trip deposit and payment schedule to be set by the trip committee. A deposit is required to sign up for a trip. Failure to meet the payment schedule may result in automatic cancellation from the trip subject to the cancellation fee in item #7.
- 6) When a trip is full the trip captain will start a waiting list. To be placed on the waiting list a member must fill out and sign a trip application and pay the standard deposit for that trip. Waiting list members must meet the payment schedules when moving to the confirmed lists.

#### **CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS**

7) Unless otherwise listed in individual trip information, cancellations prior to 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$50.00; cancellations less than 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$100.00 if the trip goes full, or liability for the full cost of the trip if the trip does not go full. Any cancellation fees or penalties may first be deducted from payments the member made for the trip. Medical cancellations will be reviewed by the Board for refund determination.

- 8) Transferring from the waiting list on one trip to a confirmed list on another trip will be done with no cancellation fee. Refusal to move from the waiting list to the confirmed list will constitute automatic cancellation subject to the cancellation fee in item #7 above.
- 9) If a trip is cancelled by the club, all money paid to the club by a member for that trip will be refunded.
- 10) All members on the waiting list when the trip departs will receive a full refund.
- 11) No refunds will be made until after the trip returns.

#### **BUS TRIPS**

- 12) Smoking on buses is prohibited.
- 13) Any time the bus stops enroute to its destination, passengers leaving the bus will do so at their own risk.
- 14) The Omaha Ski Club will not provide alcoholic beverages for any bus trip. If any members wish to consume alcoholic beverages on the trip, they can do so at their own expense, and assume all risks and liabilities associated with such consumption.
