

### **Korean Dinner**

On Tuesday evening, October 18<sup>th</sup>, ten club members enjoyed an unusual exotic dinner with Korean food and drinks at the Korea King restaurant near 96<sup>th</sup> and L streets. Some of the





tasty treats we had included Korean noodles with beef and vegetables ("bulgogi"), spiced and pickled cabbage ("kimchi"), and Korean-style grilled fish with rice. The kimchi was available in many different varieties, flavors and colors, and was interesting to look at and





taste. For drinks, we had Korean tea, beer and sake bombs, which are a combination of beer and sake (rice wine) which is suspended over the beer glass with chopsticks and then released for a quick mix. Some of us also tried at eat with chopsticks as Koreans do – it isn't easy! For dessert, we broke open some fortune cookies – not totally Korean but good for a few chuckles.

### Mt Crescent needs ski and snowboard instructors

Mt. Crescent, a ski and snowboard area located 15 minutes northeast of Omaha, is looking to add to their ski and snowboard instructor staff. Since the majority of lessons are for beginners who have never skied or boarded, the instructor's ski/board skill level needs to be only above beginner level. Other than knowing how to wedge (snowplow) and wedge turn in skiing and how to turn comfortably for snowboarding, the most important aspect of teaching beginner lessons is the instructor's attitude. The beginner needs an instructor who is positive, encouraging and caring; the rest is easy and rewarding. If this is your personality, then you would be a fantastic ski or snowboard instructor who can share the love of the sport with others.

The compensation includes payment for lessons taught, season's passes and discounts for immediate family. This is a great way to share a fun, healthy and beautiful winter activity with your family. Instructing is a proven method toward the advancement of one's own skiing and riding skills. Instructors from Mt. Crescent, who visit the mountains for a ski vacation, are able to explore a wider variety of terrain at the mountain resort; and they have a much more satisfying experience due to their newly acquired skills and proficiency in the sport. The season is approximately 11-12 weeks. The commitment is approximately 8 hours per week of being available to teach. Considerations have been made for weeks in which work or vacations may take you out of town, thus making you unavailable.

Mt. Crescent was purchased 4 seasons ago by Korby and Samantha Fleischer of Vail, Colorado. Korby and Samantha live in Iowa and are "hands-on" owners. In this day of corporate ownership of ski areas, it is rare and delightful to still have a family run area. Korby and Samantha are a ski family who grew up in a ski family. Korby's brother, Chad, was an Olympic skier for the U.S. Ski Team. Mt. Crescent has become a welcoming community of skiers, boarders and outdoor enthusiasts who love the sport, who love the ski area and who the love the community that it has become. Each year new staff, skiers and boarders are enthusiastically added to the Mt. Crescent family.

New instructors are thoroughly trained in the mechanics of the skiing/boarding skills to be taught. Understanding how people learn and the establishing of a comfortable, relaxed learning environment is also taught to each new instructor. The new instructors then "shadow" experienced instructors, until comfortable enough to go it alone.

### **OMAHA SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES**

- 1) Trip captain is the final authority on and during the trip.
- 2) Club members will conduct themselves in a mature manner at all times.
- 3) There will be a \$28.00 charge on any returned check.

#### TRIP SIGN-UP, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- 4) Only members in good standing with dues currently paid to the Omaha Ski Club may sign up for a trip. Children under the age of 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the trip. A trip application for a child under the age of 19 must be signed by a parent or guardian of the child.
- 5) By signing up for a trip a member agrees to pay the Club the full cost of the trip applied for, subject to the provisions for timely cancellation in item 7). Each trip will have its own trip deposit and payment schedule to be set by the trip committee. A deposit is required to sign up for a trip. Failure to meet the payment schedule may result in automatic cancellation from the trip subject to the cancellation fee in item 7).
- 6) When a trip is full the trip captain will start a waiting list. To be placed on the waiting list a member must fill out and sign a trip application and pay the standard deposit for that trip. Waiting list members must meet the payment schedules when moving to the confirmed lists.

#### CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- 7) Unless otherwise listed in individual trip information, cancellations prior to 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$50.00; cancellations less than 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$100.00 if the trip goes full, or liability for the full cost of the trip if the trip does not go full. Any cancellation fees or penalties may first be deducted from payments the member made for the trip.
- 8) Transferring from the waiting list on one trip to a confirmed list on another trip will be done with no cancellation fee. Refusal to move from the waiting list to the confirmed list will constitute automatic cancellation subject to the cancellation fee in item 7) above.
- 9) If a trip is cancelled by the club, all money paid to the club by a member for that trip will be refunded.
- 10) All members on the waiting list when the trip departs will receive a full refund.
- 11) No refunds will be made until after the trip returns.

#### **BUS TRIPS**

- 12) Smoking on buses is prohibited.
- 13) Any time the bus stops en route to its destination, passengers leaving the bus will do so at their own risk.
- 14) The Omaha Ski Club will not provide alcoholic beverages for any bus trip. If any members wish to consume alcoholic beverages on the trip, they can do so at their own expense, and assume all risks and liabilities associated with such consumption.
