Race Chair Report

Each year the Flatlands Ski Association (FSA) organizes race competitions at a hosting resort. The selection of the resort is determined through a competitive bidding process and is selected by the FSA Board of Directors. Nine clubs make up the FSA. These include Cornhuskers, Omaha (NE), St. Louis, Columbia (MO), Kansas City, Topeka, Wichita (KS), Oklahoma City and Tulsa (OK). Over the years, there has been fierce competition between several of the larger clubs. Omaha has historically placed in last place. One of the reasons for this has been our numbers. We are a small club. Since we have only 20-30 members on each FSA trip and the other clubs bring more, we place low. The scoring is done on a point system. Each member who participates in the race gains points for the club. These numbers are compiled for a final overall score.

This year was the 48th year of Flatland races. These races began March 21, 1965 at Crested Butte CO. The Kansas City Ski Club originated and hosted the first event. Omaha, Amarillo and Wichita Ski Club members joined in this first competition. We continue to be active members of the FSA, not only to give our members a chance to compete, but also to afford our members discounted group pricing for lodging and events for this trip.

This year Teri, Mary and Judy participated in the Women's Challenge Race on Friday after a minor delay due to someone ducking the ropes and tearing the timing wire out. Eric participated in the snowboard race on Saturday. Susan experienced her first set of gates in the Novice race on Saturday despite an injury to her leg just before the race. On Friday, El, Pat, Bill, Dave, Ben, Bruce, Mark, Phil, Rich and Lamont participated in the Men's Challenge Race. It was the first time on a race course for Bruce and Lamont. Both finished without incidence. Individual times are listed on the next page.

Another "race" is the Snowshoe race. This is a fun event and promotes teamwork as well as competition. We had two teams. The A team was Dave, Mary, Eric and Joe. The B team members were Pat, Nancy, Rich and Bruce. Our two teams came in second to last. It was all about having fun. Each year the FSA chooses a charity to collect money for. They do this through the race chairs selling raffle tickets and then having a race chair race to determine which club's bag of tickets the prize drawing will be drawn from. This year the Cornhusker Ski Club won the Race Chair Race. Eric participated for our club. Thank you for the good effort. Overall, this event isn't about winning. All the proceeds were donated to the Adaptive Sports Center. We raised \$1297.00 this year, the most collected for the charity in the 48 years of FSA. Thank you to all who donated!

Omaha came in 8th place overall out of the nine clubs that competed. I know it is time consuming but I hope you enjoyed the experience. It was really hard to spend time up there on the race course with the fresh powder. Thanks to all of you who raced for our club!

Next year, we will be in Snowmass so mark your calendars!

OMAHA SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- 1) Trip captain is the final authority on and during the trip.
- 2) Club members will conduct themselves in a mature manner at all times.
- 3) There will be a \$28.00 charge on any returned check.

TRIP SIGN-UP, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- 4) Only members in good standing with dues currently paid to the Omaha Ski Club may sign up for a trip. Children under the age of 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the trip. A trip application for a child under the age of 19 must be signed by a parent or guardian of the child.
- 5) By signing up for a trip a member agrees to pay the Club the full cost of the trip applied for, subject to the provisions for timely cancellation in item 7). Each trip will have its own trip deposit and payment schedule to be set by the trip committee. A deposit is required to sign up for a trip. Failure to meet the payment schedule may result in automatic cancellation from the trip subject to the cancellation fee in item 7).
- 6) When a trip is full the trip captain will start a waiting list. To be placed on the waiting list a member must fill out and sign a trip application and pay the standard deposit for that trip. Waiting list members must meet the payment schedules when moving to the confirmed lists.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- 7) Unless otherwise listed in individual trip information, cancellations prior to 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$50.00; cancellations less than 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$100.00 if the trip goes full, or liability for the full cost of the trip if the trip does not go full. Any cancellation fees or penalties may first be deducted from payments the member made for the trip.
- 8) Transferring from the waiting list on one trip to a confirmed list on another trip will be done with no cancellation fee. Refusal to move from the waiting list to the confirmed list will constitute automatic cancellation subject to the cancellation fee in item 7) above.
- 9) If a trip is cancelled by the club, all money paid to the club by a member for that trip will be refunded.
- 10) All members on the waiting list when the trip departs will receive a full refund.
- 11) No refunds will be made until after the trip returns.

BUS TRIPS

- 12) Smoking on buses is prohibited.
- 13) Any time the bus stops en route to its destination, passengers leaving the bus will do so at their own risk.
- 14) The Omaha Ski Club will not provide alcoholic beverages for any bus trip. If any members wish to consume alcoholic beverages on the trip, they can do so at their own expense, and assume all risks and liabilities associated with such consumption.
